

'Candy Glam' Bracelet by Jaide Lillie



Step 1

Cut a length of thread measuring 2 armspans.
Thread on a stopper bead.

Step 2

Thread on your candy beads alternating between top threading holes and bottom. For a 7" bracelet, use 21 candy beads.

Step 3

Thread on 3x size 11's, 1x 3mm bicone, 2x size 11's, 1x 8mm faceted round, 3x size 11's. Skip the 3 seeds and travel back down through the faceted round, 2 seed beads and exit the 3mm bicone. Add 3 more seeds.

Step 4

Pass through the top holes of the candy bead. Add 1 seed, 1 3mm bicone, 1 seed between each candy bead. Continue along the length of the bracelet.

Step 5

When you pass through the final candy bead, add 3 seeds, 1x 3mm bicone and 23 seeds. Pass back through the bicone, add 3 seeds, then pass through the other hole of the candy bead and up through the next candy bead. Continue this pattern on the opposite side.

Step 6

When you reach the last bead, sew back up through the candy bead next to the clasp and sew back through all the beads, exiting the candy bead on the other side of the bracelet.

Step 7

Add 1 seed, 1x4mm round/bicone and 1 seed and add in the same way down the length of the bracelet.

Step 8

Sew back through the clasp and add the layer of beading as on the opposite side.

Step 9

Sew through your work to secure the thread and cut it. Remove the stopper bead and sew in your tail thread, knotting twice as you weave it through your bracelet.

Materials

- Beading needle
- Beading thread
- Preciosa Candy beads
2x colours
- Size 11 seed beads 10g
- Swarovski 3mm bicones 1xpk
- Swarovski 4mm faceted rounds/bicones 2xpk
- Swarovski 8mm faceted round 1xbead
