Luella Droplet Earrings

Materials

Silver Rivoli Earring Base - **F0018**

Silver Plated Jumpings - **F0210**

Silver Plated Eyepins - **F0051**

Fevi Kwik Glue - **W271**

Swarovski Emerald Cut Beads x2 - **AC1526**

Swarovski 3mm Crystal Bicones - **AC106**

Swarovski 4mm Crystal Bicones - **AC1429**

Swarovski 8mm Rivolis - **AC1423**

Swarovski Bicone Pendants - **AC1318**

Swarovski 4mm Pearls - **HH337**



Step 1

Add a drop of glue into one of your earring bases and carefully place one of your 8mm Swarovski rivolis into the setting. Make sure the crystal is sitting correctly before lightly pressing it into the setting and letting the glue dry. Repeat this for your other earring.

Step 2

Thread a 3mm bicone, a 4mm bicone and another 3mm bicone onto an eyepin. Trim and loop the eyepin above the 3rd bead. Connect this to the loop on your earring base using a jumping. Repeat this step for your other earring.

Step 3

Take another eyepin and thread on a 4mm pearl bead, one of your larger rectangular emerald cut beads and another 4mm pearl bead. Trim and loop the pin above this pearl. Attach this to the lower loop of the eyepin you previously worked with. You can add another jumping inbetween this for added movement and longer earrings. Repeat this for the other earring.

Step 4

To attach the final bicone pendant, thread an eyepin through the bicones threading hole approx 5mm's. Bend the eyepin loop so it is sitting up above the bicone. There should be a small gap of approx 2/3mm between the loop and the top of the bicone. Hold the loop with flat nose pliers and grip the other end of your pin threaded through the bicone with round nose pliers. Wrap this longer section around the bare section of pin between the loop and the bicone. Trim the excess pin and repeat for the second earring. Attach these bicone pendants to the ends of your earrings.
