

**Materials used - Seed beads Toho 11 - 11TR181, 11TRPF21, 11TR981,
Crochet hook 0.75 or 0.1, thread, silver plated clasp.**

Beaded crochet ropes are worked in circular crochet.

String the seed beads on the bead cord (yarn or thread) in a pattern (see the scheme on the next pages).

Chain 12, with a bead in each stitch. Join your chain to the 1st stitch with a beaded slip stitch.

Push the hook through loop on which 1st bead is fastened; push the first bead over the hook, down to the right (left) and **BE SURE** to bring the thread from the spool **OVER** the top of the bead. Slide down the next bead and fasten with a slip stitch.

Continue on in this manner, working in a slip stitch spiral, until the desired length is reached. Care should be taken to see that there are always 12 beads around and that your pattern is looking right. If not, then unravel the work back to where it is right!

To finish the rope, cut your thread, leaving a tail and pull through the last stitch. Finally, glue your beads into your cord ends to finish your bracelet.

Instruction to the scheme - string all the beads in the pattern starting from the top. Do not cut the thread.
